Pre Launch activities of the Swachta Days:	
1	<p>Meetings of DWSM and thereafter Block Level Sanitation Committees to discuss plans regarding proposed activities to mark the Swachta Week. which will include participation from all line departments i.e. Education, I&PH, Health, I&PR, ICDS, Forest, Revenue, Police, Tourism, science and technology, PWD & Nehru Yuva Kendras:</p> <p>Following Issues needs to be addressed at District & Block level:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Strategy to cover left out habitations.2. Besides this adequate publicity to Maharishi Valmiki Sampoorna Swachta Puraskar Yojana, Mahila Mandal Protsahan Yojna, School Reward Scheme, Resource Generation Scheme by the Panchayats and Nirmal Gram Puraskar will also be given through Newspaper Advertisements, Press Releases, Radio, Kala Jathas and interpersonal contact.</p>

(Focus on S&LWM, ODF, Sustainability, Removal of Plastic waste & NGP).Slogan competition, essay competition, debates etc. at School Level. (Focus on Environment cleanliness).Use of School Children and NSS (High School) in cleanliness drive in Schools and surroundings areas.Meeting of School Management Committees to devise strategy for ensuring cleanliness in the School & Anganwadi premises along with making certain that all the school toilets are in a functional state. Make School Sanitation a regular issue of discussion during morning assemblies.Latrine Cleaning/Repair to be carried out in all Schools.Pledge for promoting Sanitation by Children – Start/ Review of Swachta Doot Scheme. 4	<p>Anganwadi Sanitation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Meeting with the parents of the Children who are enrolled in the Anganwadis.Cleaning/ Repairs of the Anganwadi toilets and fund raising for the baby friendly toilets.Doctors and Health Workers to organise Health and Sanitation Awareness cum Health Check up Camps at Anganwadi Level.
5	Provision of drinking water, hand washing facility and water facility near School & Anganwadi toilets - Involve IPH/PRI Department (Generate report about non functional toilets and active steps for their repairs be taken with support of Education department and action required)

April 3, 2010 (Sunday) :	
Sankalp Divas (Gram Sabha Day) - Commitment Day	
1	Resolution by Gram Panchayat regarding ODF, MVSSP and NGP with general discussion on the actual status of ODF reported by the VHSC in the Panchayat together with identification of difficult areas.
2	To adopt Resolution in all GPs regarding Sustainability and Solid Liquid Waste Management. Setting of mechanism for Sustainability and S&LWM (Selection of the committee which will be responsible for the SLWM at the GP level) in the Panchayat with the consent of Gram Sabha (GP Secretary/Sahayk will generate a report on Action Plan of GP & same will be submitted to concerned Development Block).
3	Discussion on various Sanitation Schemes/Awards and obtaining the consent of the Gram Sabha for participation in State Sanitation Award Scheme, MVSSP, Resource Generation Scheme of the PR Department, Mahila Mandal Protsahan Yojana, Water Harvesting Structure Scheme for Schools and for the enforcement of the Penal Provisions against the defaulters as per PR Act.
